Bold colors like red, white, and blue were pulled back in intensity and compliment any wardrobe.




Rotation

I explored the movement of the upper body for tennis athletes and designed for an uninhibited range of motion.









Footwork

For the lower body, multidirectional movement to cover the court needs to be unrestricted. Bottoms need to have a fitting waistband while allowing legs to move freely.



With a focus on a relaxed fit, I roughly blocked in the silhouette of my lineup.



The first iteration of the silhouettes has mobility at the forefront. Raglan sleeves inspired by baseball allow for a full range of upper body motion. Leg slits allow for uninhibited movement in the lower body.









Details

After eating, yoga, and taking a nap, I go back and add anything I may have overlooked. I added pockets to the jacket, added large pocket bags to the shorts, and cropped the pants.
